Friday – Confession 6pm, Stations of the Cross 6:30pm; Mass 7pm

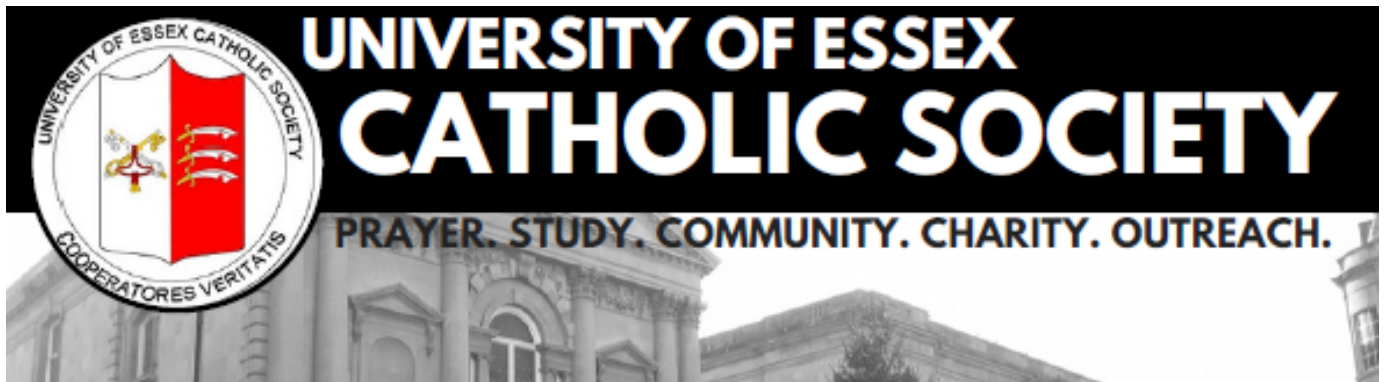
The Legion of Mary meeting is at 7:30pm – all are welcome.
