Saturday evening 8pm Sunday morning 11am tidying up afterwards

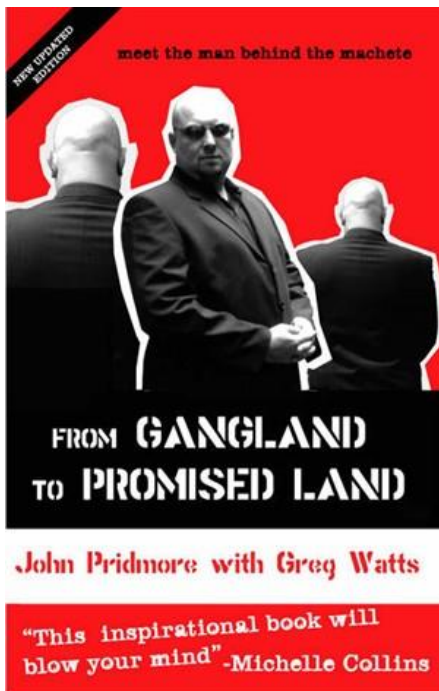
Mass and Benediction, followed by refreshments
