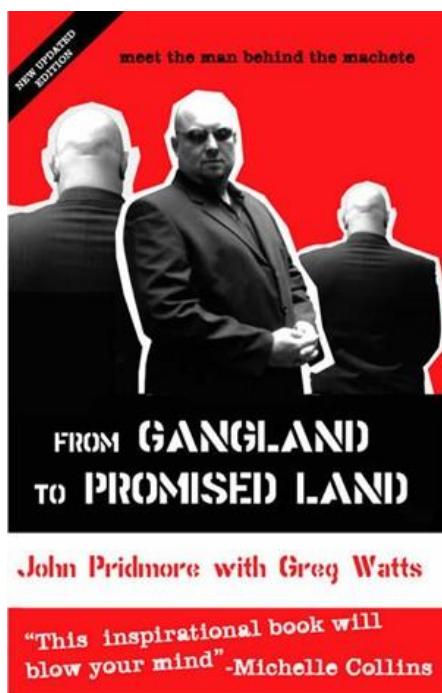


Legion of Mary, Friday, 2:30pm
